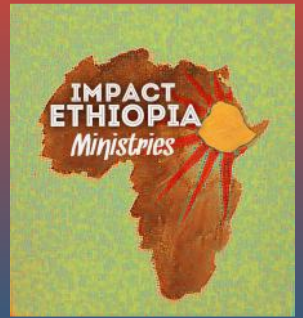

Friday, we concluded with powerful prayer and fellowship at the local park, sending them back to their communities renewed and inspired.
